To complement our swamp dozers we have engineered a range of swamp (or LGP) excavators to assist in sand pour and general earth works in residue areas. These machines have been widened to accommodate 1500mm track plates to reduce the ground pressure to 2.9PSI, half the ground pressure of a standard 20 tonne excavator.

We also have access to outsource an extensive range of equipment at competitive rates including but not limited to graders, large excavators, scrapers, and loaders.
